

# THE MICCOSUKEE WRITERS WORKSHOP



Who knows what stories your heart wants to tell? Come join a five-week writing journey in a safe, nurturing space. Escape judgment and find the creative rhythm to tell your own story – maybe it's an essay? The seed of your memoir? Who knows?

I believe the only difference between non-writers and writers is that writers sit down and write. In this workshop, we will create the structure to do that, once a week for five weeks.

**We will meet five Saturday afternoons from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m. at my home off Miccosukee Road (lots of porches, 13 miles from Capital Circle) starting Jan. 21 and ending on February 18.**

What will we do? I will guide us on our writing journey. We will write on assigned topics designed to get to our deep stories, and we will share with one another. We will write in class and also have an assignment to work on outside class during the week.

Classes are offered on a sliding scale - \$25 to \$45 per class; but for continuity within the group and for me, please commit to and pay for all six classes, even if you have to skip one. You may pay each week, or, if you like, pay for all six classes at once.
